*Summertide*

Saturday, June 15th | 1-5PM

The Summertide Solstice Art Festival is our yearly summer festival, centered around celebrating the addition of new sculptures and poems in Webster's Woods. These new additions are added throughout the park where they will remain for one year.

The festival itself is a free, family friendly celebration with live music in the meadow, food & drink vendors, poetry readings, and nature art activity stations for all ages.

In 2023 we had 704 visitors to Summertide throughout the park and gallery to enjoy our unique setting and festival atmosphere.

The Summertide Solstice Art Festival is free and open to all ages.

*Fall Festival*

**Saturday, Oct. 19th | 4-8PM**

This year will be our fourth annual Celebration of Shadows Fall Festival. Visitors can enjoy forest paths lined with pumpkins during the Pumpkin Walk, a performance in the meadow, and food & drink vendors! In 2023 we had 700 attendees at the festival, and over 80 people engaged in the pumpkin carving workshops and contest.

This year's festival will include a return of the pumpkin carving contest and walk-where people can view the pumpkins on display along the paths and an outdoor shadow themed performance in the meadow!

Community members will also be able to participate by taking our pumpkin carving workshop, entering the pumpkin carving contest, voting for their favorite carving during the festival, and enjoy food and drink from delicious local vendors.

The Fall Festival is free to attend and open to all ages.



*Wintertide Festival of Lights*

Saturday, Dec. 7th | 4-8PM

Wintertide is the Port Angeles Fine Arts Center's end of year programming that crescendos into our Wintertide Festival. In 2023, we had 505 Festival attendees, plus 1,294 through the Makers Market, and 5,845 visits to Websters Woods for the Light Art Experience.

Moving into our fourth year, we believe this event is becoming a beloved community tradition. This year we will continue to improve upon our light art installations and performances. Past performances include fire dancing by Fractal Phase, the interactive Shadow Sail Theater, and interactive light based installations by Marcell Marias and Another World Collective.

The 2024 Wintertide Festival will include food & drink vendors, lighted art illuminating the forest paths, lantern workshops and community lantern walk, and more exciting performances. Visitors can also enjoy holiday shopping in the Makers Market.



*Wintertide Makers Market*

November 29th - December 15th

The Makers Market takes place in the Esther Webster gallery and highlights the work of local artists and artisans as the gallery transforms into a festive holiday market. Shoppers will find art prints, home decor, jewelry, body care, kitchenware, cards, stickers and more.

The 2024 Makers Market will run for three weekends. Additional activities and events that will bring more traffic include a PAFAC Member's Only shopping day, extended hours on Friday evenings, and the Wintertide Festival on December 7th.

Our extended evenings include complimentary warm beverages and fire tables in the courtyard from the hours of 5pm-8pm. The extended evenings allow for shopping after the work day and encourage visitors of all ages to explore the light art in the park and shop at the market as a family or date night activity.

*Light Art Experience*

November 29th - January 1st, 2025

The Light Art Experience lights up Webster's Woods Sculpture Park with light based art installations along our forested paths. The installations add magic to the woods and bring light to our community during the darkness of winter.

The 2024 Light Art Experience will run for five weeks. The lights will be activated each night from 4pm-8pm for visitors. Walking through the park is free for the duration of the outdoor exhibition, except for the night of the Festival of Lights (Saturday, Dec. 7th). In 2023 we had over 5,800 visits to the park during our Light Art Experience, and expect to see those numbers grow.

Thursday, Aug. 22nd | 6-8PM
